S

Specific

Clearly define the goal

M

Measurable

Establish criteria to track progress

A

Achievable

Ensure the goal is realistic

R

Relevant

Establish criteria to track progress

T

Time-Bound

Set a deadline for reaching the goal

Example:



[child's name] will improve reading comprehension by answering comprehension questions with 75% accuracy after reading the text.



By [Date], [child's name] will improve reading comprehension by answering comprehension questions (main idea and details) with 75% accuracy over five trials after reading a grade-level text.
